NOTE TO OPERATOR:

As per Section 29 of the Drilling and Production Regulation, core boxes should be well constructed with ¾-inch wooden sides and ends; lid and bottom preferably of ¼-inch fir plywood held in place by <u>1-inch coated box nails</u>. Boxes should not exceed 30 inches in length and should be 2 rows wide and 1 row high. Please replace damaged core boxes before shipping to the BC Energy Regulator Core Research Facility, in Fort St. John. Please refer to the <u>Well Data Submission Requirements Manual</u> for complete submission requirements.

One end of the core box (not lid) should be labelled to show the well name and location, number, core number, interval and the box number. The top and bottom of the core should be indicated on the row dividers.
