**Order:**

Pursuant to section 38(1)(c) of the *Energy Resource Activities Act* (the Act), I, Patrick Smook, order that ARC Resources Ltd. (ARC) must:

1. Prepare a report that includes an assessment of the impacts to the Natural Range Barrier (NRB), Coplin Creek, located on the east boundary of RAN075986A (Range) associated with the energy resource activity that is near and or crosses the NRB as listed below:

2. The assessment report must be completed by a Registered Professional Agrologist, identify the impacts of the permit holder's activities on the NRB and include recommended actions required to remediate any impacts from those activities.
