Order:

Pursuant to section 38(1)(c) of the *Energy Resource Activities Act* (the Act), I, Dax Bourke, order that Secure Energy Services Inc. (Secure) must:

- 1. Develop a report completed by a Qualified Professional that must, at a minimum, identify the potential sources and causes of odours during operations and maintenance activities from Secure's Facility ID #7796 (Facility), located at 16-05-079-14. The report must also:
 - a) Identify current mitigation measures in place and any recommended additional measures to mitigate the sources and causes of odours from the Facility.
 - b) Include a rationale where no mitigation measures are recommended.
 - c) Include a required inspection and maintenance plan for the mitigation measures identified in (a), where applicable; and
 - d) Include a proposed timeline for the implementation of additional mitigation measures identified in (a), where applicable.

<u>Request:</u>

Pursuant to section 38(1)(e) of the Act, the BC Energy Regulator (BCER) requests that Secure submit a copy of the report referred to in Item 1, no later than November 29, 2024, electronically to <u>C&E@bc-er.ca</u>.



Conditions:

A. This order shall remain in effect until amended or terminated in whole or in part by the BCER.
