**RE: PRESSURE MAINTENANCE WATERFLOOD PROJECT  
APPROVAL ORDER CANCELLATION  
PEEJAY FIELD – HALFWAY FORMATION – CNRL UNIT #2**

A pressure maintenance waterflood project in the Peejay field, Halfway formation, CNRL Unit #2, was approved by the Regulator on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 1966. On July 29<sup>th</sup>, 2024, the Regulator received a request from CNRL to rescind this project approval due to upcoming well decommissioning. Oil production ceased in March of 2024.

Waterflood operation over a period of 57 years has resulted in high oil recovery, demonstrating effective resource management. A final reservoir pressure for this project was measured in April 2024.

Pursuant to the Energy Resources Activities Act (ERAA) section 75 (2)(b)(i), the Regulator may cancel, suspend or amend a designation at the request of the applicant to whom the designation was given. The pressure maintenance waterflood project approval #66-09-001 for the Peejay field, Halfway formation, CNRL Unit #2, is hereby cancelled, under the authority of ERAA section 75(2)(b). Approval cancellation terminates the use of injection wells, other than for any minor volume associated with decommissioning of injection system facilities and pipelines.
