This refers to your letter dated March14, 2000 wherein you requested approval to inject acid gas in the subject well. Also acknowledged is Petro-Canada's presentation of the technical merits of the request, in a meeting in Victoria on April 14, 2000.

Please note that two approvals were granted under Section 116 (now 100) of the <u>Petroleum and Natural Gas Act</u> to Petro-Canada for acid gas injection in 1996. Approval 96-16-001 was for the well b-88-J/94-G-1 and Approval 96-16-002 was for the well a-79-J/94-G-1. Acid gas injection was initiated in the well a-79-J effective December 5, 1996.

Breakthrough of previously injected gas and the development of newer pools in the area with higher level of acid gas concentration are the main reasons for your request. Therefore, your proposal to also inject acid gas in the well b-88-J is considered appropriate.

As the approval has already been granted, we wish to point out that the Commission must be notified, in writing, of the date of commencement of acid gas injection for the subject well as specified in condition # 13 of the Approval 96-16-001.
