**RE: APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY ACID GAS INJECTION
UPRI CARIBOU C-4-G/94-G-7; WA# 7961**

The Commission has reviewed your application dated March 13, 2000 requesting permission to inject acid gas into the Halfway formation in the subject well on a temporary basis.

The acid gas injection Approval 97-16-001 for the well c-4-G/94-G-7 came into effect on April 23, 1997. This approval terminated once the well UPRI Caribou a-A30-G/94-G-7 became an active acid gas injector (Approval 98-16-001).

To allow UPRI to use the well c-4-G to be used as a temporary acid gas injector in case the current injector a-A30-G becomes plugged is considered appropriate. This temporary approval will allow UPRI to conduct a production test of the well c-4-G and avoid acid gas flaring at the Caribou plant.

In view of the above, Approval 97-16-001 will become effective for a period not exceeding beyond May 1, 2000. Should acid gas injection be required, UPRI must notify the Manager, Operations Engineering, the date of commencement and the date of termination of this temporary acid gas injection. A report on the results of the flow test must be included in the next Progress Report.
