RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION CANHUNTER KELLY c-96-B/093-P-1; WA# 12235

The Commission has reviewed your application dated July 6, 2001, requesting permission to commingle gas production from the Cadotte and Falher A pools encountered in the subject well. Also, we acknowledge receipt of the supplementary information submitted in a latter dated August 1, 2001.

The Commission has designated the gas pools under application to be the Kelly - Cadotte "H" and Falher A "B". Both pools contain mainly sweet gas; any potential crossflow should be from Falher A to Cadotte having no detrimental effect on other producing wells. Commingled production is expected to increase gas production by mitigating liquid loading problems.

We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production is hereby approved, under the authority of section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Production from the Cadotte (2263.0–2266.0 mKB) and Falher A (2373.0–2385.0 mKB) zones may be commingled.
- 2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated on the Ministry of Energy and Mines BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Cadotte 50% and Falher A 50%.
- 3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
