**RE: COMMINGLED PRODUCTION APPROVAL**  
**CNRL PEEJAY d-55-I/94-A-15; WA# 8662**

The Commission has reviewed your application dated February 15, 2007 requesting permission to commingle gas production from the Gething and Baldonnel formations in the subject well.

The Commission designates the gas pools under application to be the Peejay field – Gething “B” and Baldonnel “H”.

The Gething is part of a multi well pool whereas the Baldonnel is mapped as a single well pool, all operated by CNRL. The Gething has produced  $17.6 \text{ } 10^6 \text{ m}^3$  and capable of producing at  $7.0 \text{ } 10^3 \text{ m}^3/\text{d}$ . The Baldonnel has produced  $11.1 \text{ } 10^6 \text{ m}^3$  and capable of  $6.0 \text{ } 10^3 \text{ m}^3/\text{d}$ . However, production from the Baldonnel has been intermittent due to liquid loading. Commingled production is expected to help alleviate liquid loading thereby increasing the productive life of the well and maximizing recoverable reserves.

We wish to advise that your application to commingle production from these zones is hereby granted approval, under the authority of Section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

1. Production from the Gething (998.0 – 1002.0 mKB) and Baldonnel (1012.7 – 1018.7 mKB) zones may be commingled.
2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated on the Ministry of Small Business and Revenue BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Gething 50% and Baldonnel 50 %.
3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
