**RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION  
CNRL ET AL PEEJAY d-43-I/94-A-15; WA# 893**

The Ministry has reviewed your application dated June 4, 1998, requesting permission to commingle gas production from the Gething 'A' and Halfway 'H' pools encountered in the subject well.

The Peejay Gething "A" is a single well pool. The Halfway "H" pool consists of three wells which are included in a Concurrent Production project. Oil production from the project well d-33-I/94-A-15 ceased in May 1989, the gascap well d-43-I is the only remaining producer in the scheme.

Current reservoir pressure, depletion and fluid composition are similar for the two pools, with the Halfway being slightly sour.

We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production from these two formations is hereby approved, under the authority of section 44 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

1. Production from the Gething (982.1-987.2 mKB) and Halfway (1119.2-1120.4 mKB) formations may be commingled.
2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated on the BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Gething 90% and Halfway 10%.
3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
