

The OGC has reviewed your application dated February 9, 2005, for approval to commingle gas production from two Cadomin intervals in the subject well.

The subject well has encountered two Cadomin zones separated by a thrust fault, with the upper Cadomin repeat occurring from 3238 m MD - 3247.4 m MD and the lower Cadomin from 3267.4 m MD - 3282.2 m MD. The Commission has determined that these two Cadomin zones, as result of there proximity (25 m), are likely connected through faulting and fracturing and as such will be considered as one pool. Therefore, formal approval and allocation factors will not be required for the upper and lower Cadomin zones.
