**RE: APPROVAL FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION
DEVON TOMMY c-A89-H/94-G-9; WA# 15493**

The Commission has reviewed your applications dated February 27 and March 12, 2003 for approval to commingle gas production from the Bluesky and Halfway zones encountered in the subject well.

The Commission has designated the gas pools under application to be the Tommy Lakes - Bluesky "A" and Halfway "A". Interim commingling was approved on March 5, 2003 to allow the acquisition of additional supporting data for a formal commingling application.

Gas compositions and reservoir pressures for these pools is very similar. Commingled production is expected to aid Halfway zone gas production by mitigating liquid loading problems, thereby increasing recoverable reserves.

We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production from these zones is hereby granted approval, under the authority of Section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

1. Production from the Bluesky (1128.0 - 1129.5 mKB) and Halfway (1209.5 - 1211.5 mKB) formations may be commingled.
2. Gas production should be allocated on the Ministry of Provincial Revenue BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Bluesky 85 % and Halfway 15%. Condensate and water production should be allocated 100% to the Halfway. The allocation factors may be amended to reflect results of any future tests.
3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
