RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION
ENCAL ZAREMBA c-47-I/94-H-6; WA# 10418

The Commission has reviewed your application dated January 18, 1999, requesting permission to commingle gas production from the Bluesky "G" and Gething "C" pools encountered in the subject well.

Reservoir pressure and gas compositions are similar for the two pools. Commingling would increase the producing life of the well which produces at low rates from both pools, thereby increasing the recoverable reserves. We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production from these pools is hereby approved, under the authority of Section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

1. Production from the Bluesky "G" pool (1161.0 - 1162.0 mKB) and Gething "C" (1185.0 - 1188.0 mKB) pools may be commingled.
2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated on the Ministry of Energy and Mines BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Bluesky 50% and Gething 50%.
3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
