The Ministry has reviewed your application dated February 19, 1998, requesting permission to commingle gas production from the Martin field Bluesky "J" and Gething "D" pools encountered in the subject well.

Reservoir pressure and fluid composition are similar for these two pools. We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production from these two formations is hereby approved, under the authority of Section 44 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

1. Production from the Bluesky "J" (1169.5 - 1173.8 mKB) and Gething "D" (1174.5 - 1195.7 mKB) pools may be commingled.
2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated on the BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Bluesky 50% and Gething 50%.
3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
