The Commission has reviewed your application dated December 17, 1998 requesting permission to commingle gas production from the Gething 'F' and Halfway 'A' pools encountered in the subject well.

Reservoir pressure and fluid composition are similar for the two pools. Commingling would minimize surface disturbance as well as increasing the production life of the well, thereby increasing the recoverable reserves.

We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production from these two formations is hereby approved, under the authority of section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Production from the Gething (1121.0 1124.0 mKB) and Halfway (1229.5 1231.5 mKB) formations may be commingled.
- 2. Gas, condensate and water production should initially be allocated on the Ministry of Energy and Mines BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Gething 50% and Halfway 50%. The allocation factors may be amended to reflect results of future tests, as proposed in your application.
- 3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
