**RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION
NUMAC MARTIN c-64-G/94-H-6; WA# 9599**

The Commission has reviewed your application dated February 2, 2000 requesting permission to commingle gas production from the Martin field Gething "G" and Baldonnel "L" single well pools, encountered in the subject well.

The Commission recognizes that these two zones have been placed in communication behind pipe via an earlier frac treatment. Restimulation and production in a commingled configuration would minimize surface disturbance as well as increasing the production life of the well, thereby increasing the recoverable reserves.

We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production from these two formations is hereby approved, under the authority of section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

1. Production from the Gething (1112.5 – 1116.0 mKB) and Baldonnel (1120.5 - 1125.0 mKB) formations may be commingled.
2. Gas, condensate and water production should initially be allocated on the Ministry of Energy and Mines BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Gething 25% and Baldonnel 75%.
3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
