RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION PC et al Jedney D-64-E/94-G-8; WA# 9383

The Commission has reviewed your application dated March 1, 2000 requesting permission to commingle gas production from the Baldonnel and Nancy zones encountered in the subject well.

The Commission has designated the gas pools in this well to be Baldonnel/Upper Charlie Lake "A" and Nancy "A" of the Jedney field. It is noted that Nancy zone appears to be in pressure communication behind pipe with Baldonnel/Upper Charlie Lake "A" pool in the offsetting well UPRI Jedney b-62-E/94-G-8 (WA 6669). As a result pressure depletion is occurring in the Nancy "A" pool in the subject well. Commingling would offer an economic ability to produce gas from the Nancy "A" pool.

We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production from these two pools is hereby approved, under the authority of section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Production from the Baldonnel/ Upper Charlie Lake "A" and Nancy "A" pools may be commingled.
- 2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated on the Ministry of Energy and Mines BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Baldonnel/Upper Charlie Lake 83 % and Nancy 13%.
- 3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
