The Commission has reviewed your application dated August 27, 2001 requesting permission to commingle gas production from the Artex, Halfway and Doig zones encountered in the subject well.

Intervals identified in your application as Artex and Doig have been tentatively evaluated by Commission staff as members of the Halfway formation. Thus, formal commingling approval under the authority of section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation* is not required for the proposed completion. As well, previous welltest data from this area would suggest that these zones are likely in communication via natural fractures.
