RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION
PC AEC TOMMY d-84-L/94-G-9; WA# 10758

The Ministry has reviewed your application dated February 11, 1998, requesting permission to commingle gas production from the Halfway 'A' and Doig 'A' gas pools encountered in the subject well.

Reservoir pressure, gas production rates and fluid composition appear to be similar for the two zones.

The application to commingle production from these two formations is hereby approved, under the authority of Section 44 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

1. Production from the Halfway (1037.5 - 1049.5 mKB) and Doig (1064.5 - 1074.0 mKB) formations may be commingled.
2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated on the BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Halfway 50% and Doig 50%.
3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
