**RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION  
REMINGTON NIG a-69-A/94-H-4; WA# 819**

The Commission has reviewed your application dated December 7, 1999 requesting permission to commingle gas production from the Baldonnel and Gething zones encountered in the subject well.

The Commission has designated the gas pools encountered by this well to be Baldonnel "A" and Dunlevy "A". Commingled completion would appear to offer an economic ability to produce marginal zones, thereby increasing reserves recovery.

We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production from these two pools is hereby approved, under the authority of section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

1. Production from the Dunlevy (1275.9–1282.0 mKB) and Baldonnel (1303.3–1312.5 mKB) zones may be commingled.
2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated on the Ministry of Energy and Mines BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Dunlevy 25% and Baldonnel 75%.
3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
