RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION STAR PARKLAND 10-19-81-16 W6M; WA# 12164

The Commission has reviewed your application dated January 24, 2000 requesting permission to commingle gas production from the two Kiskatinaw sands encountered in the subject well.

The Commission interprets the two Kiskatinaw sands encountered in the well to be two separate gas accumulations, which have been assigned separate pool designations. The Commission has designated these gas pools to be Kiskatinaw "A" and Basal Kiskatinaw "C". As reservoir pressures and fluid compositions are similar for the two pools, commingling is considered appropriate, as it would minimize surface disturbance as well as increasing the productive life.

Therefore, we wish to advise that your application to commingle production from these two pools is hereby approved, under the authority of section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Production from the Kiskatinaw "A" and Basal Kiskatinaw "C" pools may be commingled.
- 2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated on the Ministry of Energy and Mines BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Kiskatinaw 40% and Basal Kiskatinaw 60%.
- 3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
