RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION STAR PARKLAND 12-20-81-16 W6M; WA# 13033

The Commission has reviewed your application, dated October 11, 2000, requesting permission to commingle gas production from the two Kiskatinaw sands encountered in the subject well.

The Commission interprets the two Kiskatinaw sands encountered in the well to be two separate gas accumulations, which have been assigned separate pool designations, the Kiskatinaw "A" and Basal Kiskatinaw "C". The fluid compositions are similar for the two pools, commingling is considered appropriate, as it would increase the productive life. Also, the Commission has previously approved commingling production from the same field and pools in the well 10-19-81-16 W6M, also operated by Star.

Therefore, we wish to advise that your application to commingle production from these two pools is hereby approved, under the authority of section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Production from the Kiskatinaw "A" and Basal Kiskatinaw "C" pools may be commingled.
- 2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated on the Ministry of Energy and Mines BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Kiskatinaw 15% and Basal Kiskatinaw 85%.
- 3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.

Please note that under section 95 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation* the requirement for initial pressure measurements is hereby waived.
