**RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION
SUNCOR N BOUNDARY 6-7-088-14 W6M; WA# 9928**

The Commission has reviewed your application dated December 8, 2004 requesting permission to commingle production from the Coplin and Halfway zones encountered in the subject well.

The Commission has designated these pools as the Boundary Lake North – Coplin “I” and Halfway “K” single well non-associated gas pools. Gas analyses indicate that the Halfway zone is sour and the Coplin zone is sweet. Additionally the reservoir pressures for each zone are not expected to be similar. However, the well is configured with a sliding sleeve which should mitigate any concerns regarding cross-flow during extended shut-in periods. Commingled production should extend the economic life of this well, thereby maximizing reserves recovery.

We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production is hereby approved, under the authority of Section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

1. Production from the Coplin (1250.0–1251.0 mKB) and Halfway (1300.0–1307.0 mKB) zones may be commingled.
2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated on the Ministry of Provincial Revenue BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Coplin 15% and Halfway 85%.
3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
