The Oil and Gas Commission has reviewed your e-mail request dated August 27, 2007 for approval to commingle gas production from the Falher, Cadomin and Nikanassin zones in the subject well. Initial approval was granted via e-mail correspondence on August 29, 2007. Initial approval is intended to allow the acquisition of addition supporting data for a formal application.

As noted in your application, most of the gas production is expected from the Nikanassin zone. Commingled completion should allow the secondary Falher and Cadomin zones to be produced, thereby increasing well gas recovery.

We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production is hereby granted **interim** approval, under the authority of Section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions being met:

- 1. Production from the Falher, Cadomin and Nikanassin formations may be commingled.
- 2. A production test must be completed to establish the AOF and initial reservoir pressure for the commingled zones, and reports filed as per the requirements of Sections 84 and 95 of the *Regulation*.
- 3. A formal application for commingled production must be submitted with supporting test data, gas analysis and proposed allocation factors for production reporting.
- 4. Formal approval for commingled production **will not** be authorized until all of the conditions above have been met.
