## THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS ACT MINISTRY OF EMPLOYMENT AND INVESTMENT ENERGY AND MINERALS DIVISION

IN THE MATTER of a Concurrent Production proposal of Calahoo Petroleum Ltd. (Calahoo) for producing a portion of the Fort St. John North Pine "A" Pool with a project oil and gas allowable.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Division Head, pursuant to section 97 of the <u>Petroleum and Natural</u> <u>Gas Act</u> (the Act), hereby approves the Concurrent Production project of Calahoo for oil and gas production with project allowables by amending existing approvals, as such project is described in

an Application from Calahoo to the Division dated May 2, 1997, and related submission.

This project is approved, subject to the conditions herein contained and, in particular:

- 1. The area of the project shall consist of Sections 25, 26 and S/2 Section 35-83-18 W6M.
- 2. The project reserves based oil allowable is 32.9 m<sup>3</sup>/d.
- 3. The project reserves based gas production limit is  $37.4 \cdot 10^3 \text{m}^3 / \text{d}$ .
- 4. All associated gas production must be conserved.
- 5. This approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate.
