**RE: REQUEST FOR CONCURRENT PRODUCTION APPROVAL AMENDMENT
STODDART NORTH PINE "F" POOL**

The Ministry has reviewed your letter received March 23, 1998, requesting an amendment to the Concurrent Production scheme approval 98-07-002, for a portion of the subject pool.

The new well Calahoo et al Stoddart 8-14-86-19 (WA# 11256) has been evaluated as intersecting the gas cap to this oil pool. In order to maximize recovery of oil, this well must not produce from the North Pine zone without approval, as per section 90(5) of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*. The Concurrent Production scheme production allowables are based on the sum of the daily oil allowables and a base production GOR and not strictly reserves based. Therefore the approval area and allowables will not be amended to include the well 8-14-86-19.
