**RE: RESCIND CEASE PRODUCTION ORDER  
NORTHPINE BOUNDARY 14-30-84-14 W6M; WA# 21070**


Commission staff have reviewed your request to rescind the cease production order issued January 16, 2007.

On May 13, 2009 the Commission issued Northpine Energy an approval for temporary concurrent production; allowing up to  $3.0 \times 10^6$  m<sup>3</sup> of gas production from the subject well. The purpose of the temporary approval was to allow additional volumes of hydrocarbons to be concurrently produced from the wells 10-31-84-14 W6M (WA# 21839) and 14-30-84-14 W6M (WA# 21070) and subsequent reservoir pressures obtained. The Commission believed that this additional reservoir information would provide evidence to refute or confirm that these two wells were within the same pool.

The Commission has reviewed the well test analysis and reserves evaluation information provided by ATECH Application Technology, on behalf of Northpine Energy, dated September 8, 2009. Based on the technical analysis performed by Commission staff in conjunction with the information provided by ATECH the Commission has concluded that the two wells, WA# 21070 and WA# 21839 are separate single well pools. Therefore, effective immediately the cease production order issued on January 16, 2009 has been rescinded. The subject well may be placed back on production without any gas allowable restrictions. Please note that this decision is subject to review and modification should it be deemed necessary.
