The Commission has reviewed your application dated December 23, 2002 requesting approval for a Good Engineering Practice (GEP) scheme for the North Border area.


Please note that the Commission designates the gas pool under application to be the Ring field Bluesky-Gething-Montney "E" pool.

IN THE MATTER of a Good Engineering Practice (GEP) scheme of Burlington Resources Canada (Burlington) for producing the Ring field Bluesky-Gething-Montney "E" pool gas without well spacing and target restrictions.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission, pursuant to Part 8, Division 6, Section 101 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, hereby approves the GEP scheme of Burlington for drilling wells without spacing and target restrictions, as such scheme is described in

*an Application from Burlington to the Commission dated December 23, 2002.*

This scheme is approved, subject to the conditions herein contained and, in particular:

1. The area of the scheme shall consist of:

94-H-16

Block G – unit 91

Block H – units 56-59, 66-69, 74-79, 84-89, 94-100


Block I – units 4-10, 16-20, 26-30, 38-40, 48-50, 58-60, 68-70

Block J – units 1, 11, 21, 31, 41, 51 and 61.

2. The requirements of Section 10 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation* are hereby waived, provided that gas wells within the scheme area are not completed nearer than 250 m to the sides of the approved scheme area.

3. The gas wells within the scheme area may be produced without individual well allowable restrictions.

4. This approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate.
