RE: GOOD ENGINEERING PRACTICE APPROVAL RESCINDED
JUNIOR – SLAVE POINT "A", "B" AND "D" POOLS

A Good Engineering Practice (GEP) approval was issued January 7, 1980 for the subject pools. A condition of the GEP approval, and principle reason for application, is a project based daily gas allowable (DGA), to allow production from any one or combination of wells.

Wells formerly producing from the Junior Slave Point "A" and "D" pools are now abandoned. Subsequent experience has shown that individual well allowables are more appropriate for controlling well production from these water drive pools.

Therefore, the GEP approval issued January 7, 1980, pertaining to the Junior Slave Point "A", "B" and "D" pools, is hereby rescinded. Any future production will require the application and approval of individual well DGAs.
